JANUARY WEATHER: January is the coldest month in St. Augustine, with an average high-temperature of 66°F (18.9°C) and an average low-temperature of 46°F (7.8°C). In January, in St. Augustine, the rain falls for 8 days. Throughout January, 2.7" (68.6mm) of precipitation is accumulated. In St. Augustine, during the entire year, the rain falls for 116 days and collects up to 50" (1269.9mm) of precipitation. Months with the lowest UV index in St. Augustine, Florida, are January and December, with an average maximum UV index of 4.
