Father's Day June 21: Father's Day will be celebrated on Sunday, June 21. This happens to be just one day after the summer solstice (June 20 at 5:44 P.M. Eastern Time), making it the first full day of the summer season and one of the longest days of the year. Enjoy the extra sunlight! The first known Father's Day service occurred at the Williams Memorial Methodist Episcopal Church South in Fairmont, West Virginia, on July 5, 1908, thanks to the efforts of Grace Golden Clayton. Dryer Vents: It is important that you clean your dryer vent annually. Please clean or have them cleaned and marked with your unit number. Once done notify the office.

Pool Hours Extended: We have extended our pool hours. Social distancing is still needed at the pool from 9AM to dusk. Please continue to keep our pool a pleasant place for all of our residents. Because of the reduction in capacity as we fight COVID 19, we require that no guest be invited to the pool. Also please note the rules posted at the pool. No food should be brought into the pool area.

Gym Opened: Our Gym is now opened for your convenience. Social distancing is required in the gym also. For this reason, we have not opened the Basketball court. Basketball is not conducive to social distancing.

Dumpster/Recycling: We will be getting a new dumpster in June. While this doesn't sound exciting, it is offering a savings opportunity for The Preserve. Instead of leasing the dumpster we will own it. Please wait for the compactor to stop running when disposing trash. Throwing it into the dumpster while it is running causes the trash to land on top of the compactor. Someone has to physically remove it from the top. Also note that plastic bags, garbage, and food covered items are not recyclable. We want to be environmentally conscious. They will discontinue our recycling program if violations continue. Items accepted for recycling are clearly posted.

Property Value: Despite the virus there has been a lot of condo sales at the Preserve. Property values are going up.
