

MAY DAY: May Day is a celebration of the seasons changing as well as a day to celebrate workers' rights. On May 1, 1886, hundreds of thousands of U.S. industrial workers participated in a nationwide strike to demand an eight-hour workday. (At the time, it was common to work 10- to 16-hour days, according to Industrial Workers of the World.) The protests in Chicago lasted for several days, and on May 3, a strike at McCormick Reaper Works ended in a brawl with police officers. Several strikers were wounded or killed. <u>CINCO DE MAYO:</u> Cinco de Mayo, or the fifth of May, is a holiday that celebrates the date of the Mexican army's May 5, 1862 victory over France at the Battle of Puebla during the Franco-Mexican War. The day, which falls on Wednesday, May 5 in 2021, is also known as Battle of Puebla Day. <u>TURTLE NESTING SEASON:</u> From May 1 through October 31, turtle nesting season takes place along Florida's beaches, and there are a few things to keep in mind in order to protect these creatures. Do not use flashlights at night. Fill in sand holes. Take all food and trash with you. Avoid using fireworks on the beach. Touching a sea turtle is illegal.
