AC DRAIN LINES: Another reminder that our ACs are working overtime in this heat and humidity. Please keep your AC drain lines clear by pouring a little vinegar in them. [Cleaning Your AC Drain Line Using Vinegar in 3 Steps](#)

1. Locate the Drain Line. The condensate drain is a PVC pipe typically located outside near the compressor, attached to a wall of your home. ...
2. Pour in the Vinegar. Remove the drain line plug and pour in ¼ cup of distilled vinegar. ...
